

Opening Ceremony




International Collaboration

Attendees by Commercial Focus




Attendees by Purchasing Authority


Attendees by Professional Profile

Opening Keynote

Thailand's Clean Mobility And Future Roadmap

- Thailand's journey towards the goal of transforming the mobility landscape of Southeast Asia and beyond is encapsulated in the "Thailand Clean Mobility" programme, which is not just a policy framework, but a call-to-action to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from the transport sector, significantly.
- Thailand aims to be a leader in ASEAN's mobility transformation, exemplifying how regional co-operations and technological actions can yield substantive benefits in tracking global challenges.
- Challenges such as hard risks in infrastructure development, technology adaptions and public acceptance are prevalent in Thailand, and this requires innovation, persistence and cooperation.



Leadership Panel

Southeast Asia's Evolutionary Drive: Game **Changers in Mobility Transformation**

- Last year alone, Southeast Asia had a total sales of 25 million motorbikes - half of which were by Indonesia, with Vietnam in second place, and Thailand and Philippines coming close.
- SEA has a fast growing economy but what is unique is the socio-economic infrastructure and also the urban-rural populations. Are there enough efforts for all populations or is there a biased focus on the cities only?
- Government incentives and the process of phasing out old vehicles should be made available not just for the OEMs, but for the entire mobility value chain.
- The amount of data that is being associated with cars or batteries that we are making is massive. There is a need for new technologies to grab these data by associating it with products that are still designed in an old-school way.

With Al-powered matchmaking features, participants were able to network and explore business opportunities with other visitors, delegates, speakers, exhibitors and sponsors.




2025 Floorplan
