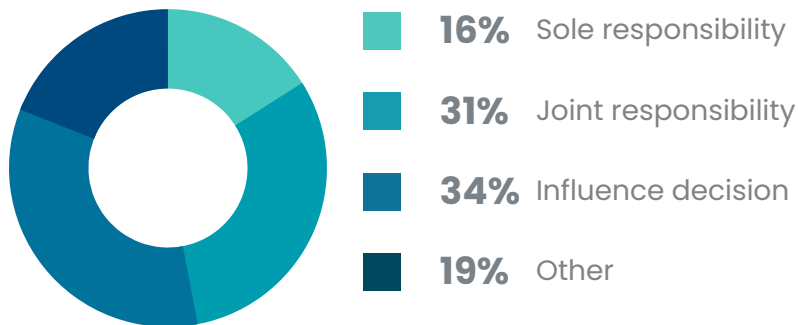
ATTENDEE OVERVIEW

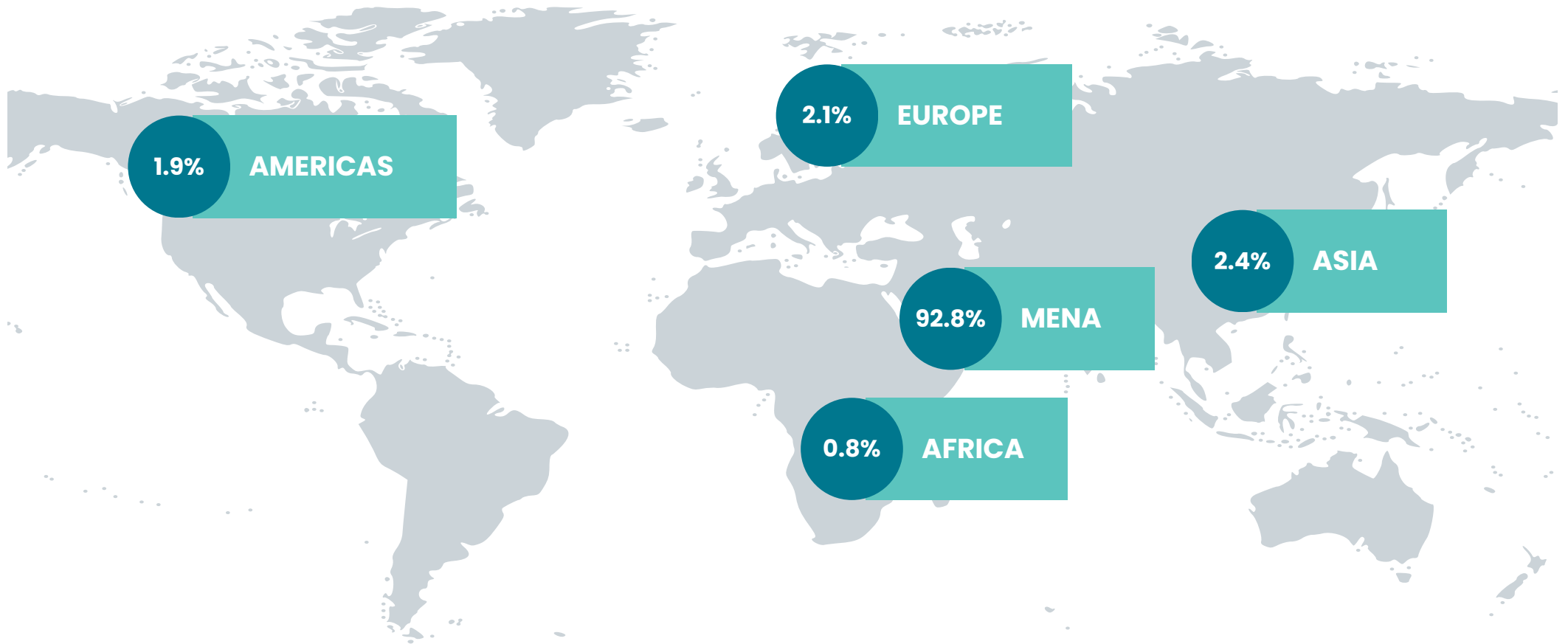
